RE: Electric Vehicle Fee

DATE: July 1, 2024

Under New Jersey law effective July 1, 2024, zero emission vehicles (ZEVs) are subject to an annual fee in addition to the existing registration fee. The additional fee applies to any vehicle certified as a ZEV pursuant to the California Air Resources Board ZEV standards for the applicable model year. The additional fee is payable in full at the time of initial registration and at every renewal. Beginning July 1, 2024, the annual fee is \$250. The annual fee increases \$10 per year for four years thereafter. For new ZEV purchases, four years of the additional fee is due at the time of purchase. For example, for new ZEVs purchased between July 1, 2024, and June 30, 2025, the additional fee due and payable at the time of initial registration is for the years 2024, 2025, 2026 and 2027.

The New Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission (NJMVC) is in the process of programming changes to implement the new fee. For ZEVs purchased between July 1, 2024, and August 31, 2024, the NJMVC will collect the additional fee after the purchase date. ZEV purchasers will receive a notice of the additional fee in September 2024. For ZEV registration renewals due between July 1, 2024, and November 1, 2024, that have already been mailed out to the customer, the ZEV owner will receive a supplemental notice with the additional fee due.
