INTRODUCTION

This report provides a summary of the significant impact that franchised new car and truck dealers have on the New Jersey economy. As clearly illustrated, the automotive retailing industry is critically important to the health of the State’s economy.

The report includes estimates of direct and indirect employment, personal income, and tax collections during 2025. Indirect impact accounts for the residual contribution resulting from dealership operations (frequently referred to as the “multiplier effect”). This report was prepared by Auto Outlook, Inc., an independent automotive market analysis firm, and is sponsored by the New Jersey Coalition of Automotive Retailers.

Methodology

Dealership financial data (and other information cited in this report) was collected from information reported by New Jersey franchised automotive retailers in 2026, based on the prior year's data.

The economic impact of the industry is separated into two main categories: direct and indirect. Direct impact comprises economic activity at automotive dealerships themselves. Indirect impact occurs away from the dealership proper, and takes into account the extended contribution dealerships make to the State’s economy.

Auto Outlook, Inc. is a regional automotive market analysis firm providing market research services to automotive dealerships.

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE



Once again, New Jersey's franchised new car and truck dealers have proven the auto retail sector remains a strong contributor to the Garden State economy. According to the data from our 2026 Economic Impact Study, dealers are demonstrating they are a vital source of secure, good-paying, local jobs that continue to support the communities they work in and serve.

Last year, affordability became a critical obstacle for many consumers in the auto retail market. Persistent inflation and roller-coaster tariffs on auto parts and vehicles built outside the U.S. ultimately made it more difficult for many customers to purchase a new vehicle at their local dealership. Family budgets were also squeezed by the increase in cost on groceries; healthcare; auto and homeowners' insurance; and utilities.

In spite of these hardships, the auto retail industry held fast to its role as a critical economic anchor in the State. Rooted in their communities, New Jersey's franchised new car and truck dealers **directly employ over 38,200** hard-working men and women in stable jobs that can't be outsourced, supporting local families and businesses through their **total compensation of nearly \$3.62 billion** last year. **These 530+ rooftops also support more than 35,500 additional jobs** in the Garden State economy.

In 2025, the auto retail sector **generated more than \$43.8 billion in revenue and sold nearly 444,000 new vehicles**. Our franchised new car and truck dealers also exceeded **\$2.1 billion in paid state and local taxes**, which bolster the essential programs all New Jerseyans rely on and contributed another **\$26.2 million in donations to hundreds of charitable causes**.

It was a relatively solid economic year for auto retail in 2025, but the electric vehicle market faced headwinds. With the elimination of the New Jersey EV Sales Tax Exemption, an added EV Registration fee, reduced State incentives for EVs, and the expiration of federal government tax credits on EVs, electric vehicles were more expensive in New Jersey last year. This reality was also reflected in the first quarter of 2026, with a sharp decline of battery electric vehicle market share in New Jersey and noticeable shift to hybrids.

As we always say, dealers want to sell what consumers want to buy. They are ready and willing to serve the communities where they live and work. Investing in their local towns and cities is a way of life for auto dealers, and New Jersey is better because of their continued investment.

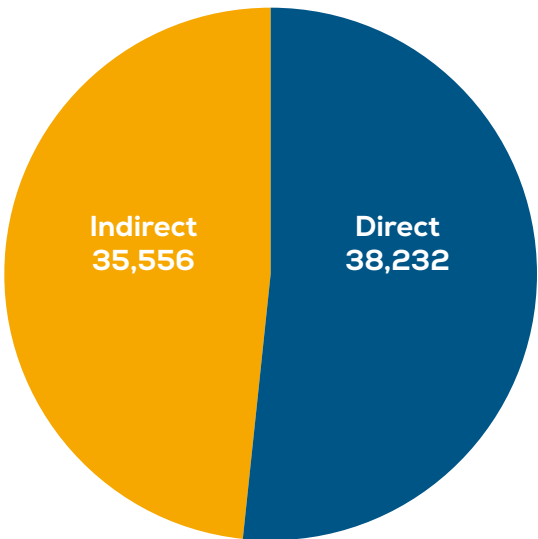

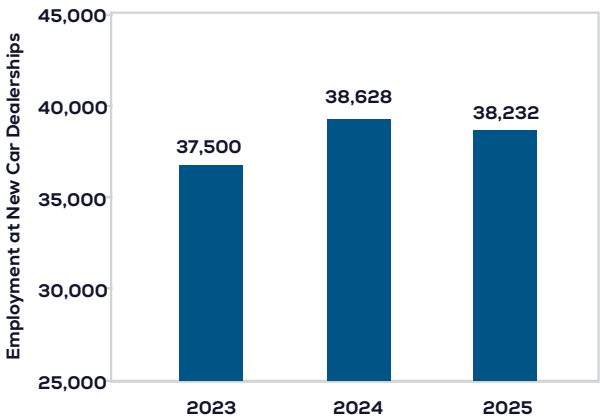

AUTO RETAILING INDUSTRY - 2025

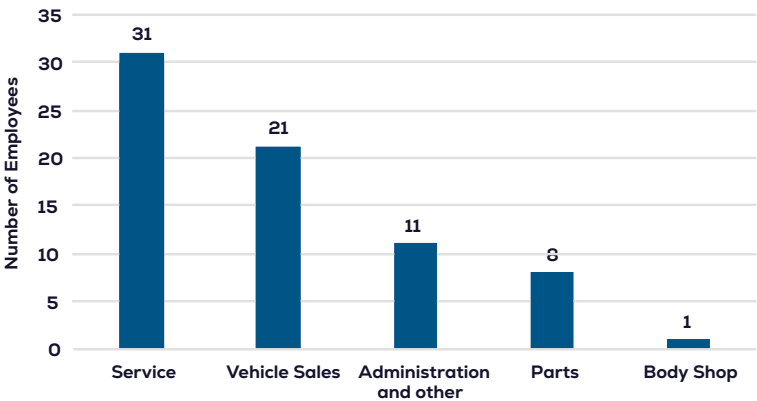

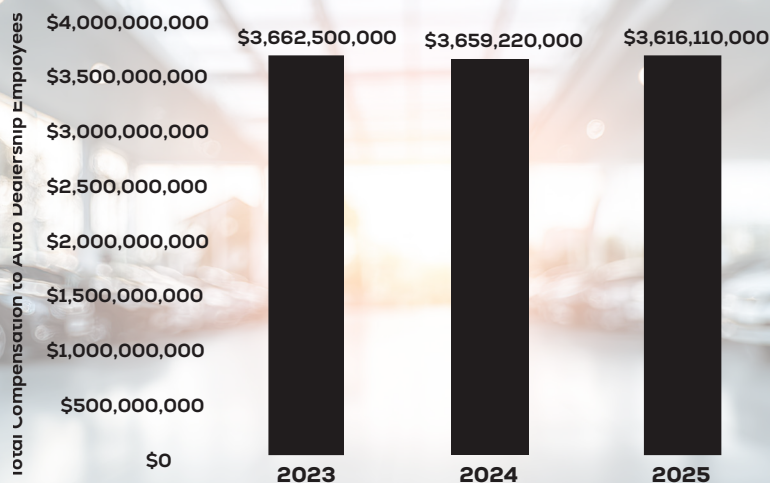
Employee Compensation in the Franchised Auto Retailing Industry – 2025 \$3.62 BILLION

In 2025, the average New Jersey dealership paid \$6.81 million to its employees (*including fringe benefits*). Including both direct and indirect sources, the new car and truck retailing industry resulted in more than \$5 billion of total compensation to New Jersey residents!

Dealership compensation declined slightly from 2024 to 2025, but was up by nearly 25% from 2020.

New car dealerships continue to provide high-paying jobs to New Jersey residents. The average salary per employee exceeded \$94,000 in 2025.

TAXES

Total State and Local Taxes Collected OR Paid by Franchised New Car and Truck Dealerships – 2025 \$2.1 Billion

In 2025, franchised new car and truck dealerships in New Jersey collected or paid more than \$2.1 billion in state and local taxes, an average of \$4 million per dealership. Estimated federal taxes for the industry were \$1.05 billion.

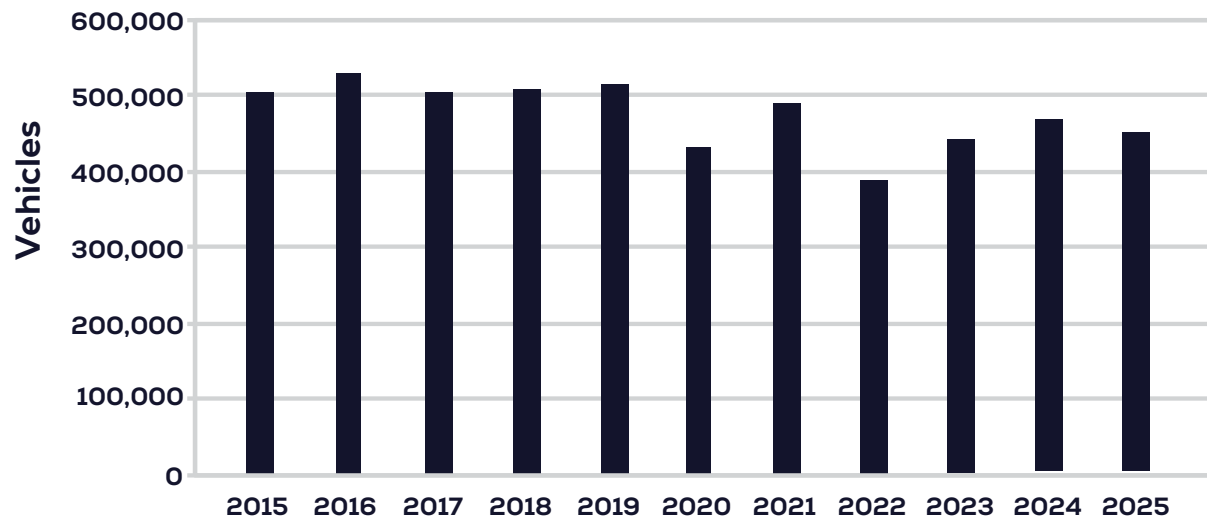
NEW VEHICLE MARKET

As shown on the graph, combined new retail car and light truck registrations in the State declined sharply in 2020 due to the pandemic, improved in 2021, and then fell 20.8% in 2022 as supply chain issues impacted vehicle production. Registrations improved in 2023 and 2024 as vehicle inventories recovered, and declined 4.3% last year.

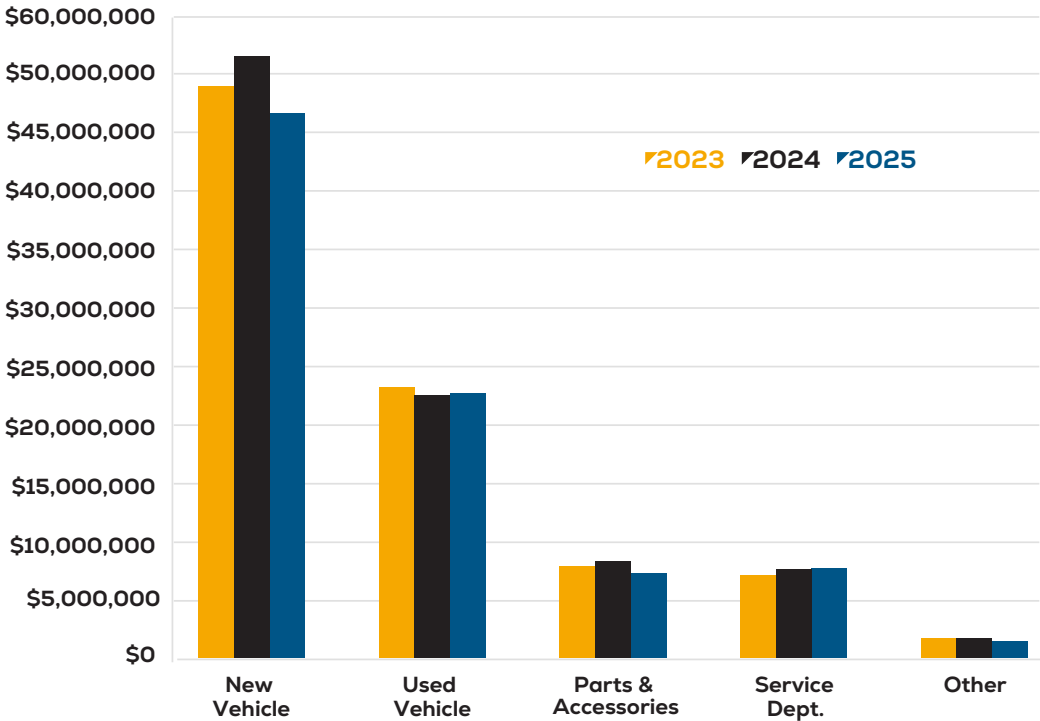

Total sales for franchised new car and truck dealerships in New Jersey exceeded \$43.8 billion in 2025. Average dealership sales were \$82.5 million, with the majority resulting from new car and truck sales.

Total dealership sales fell 3.4% last year, primarily due to declining new car and truck sales.

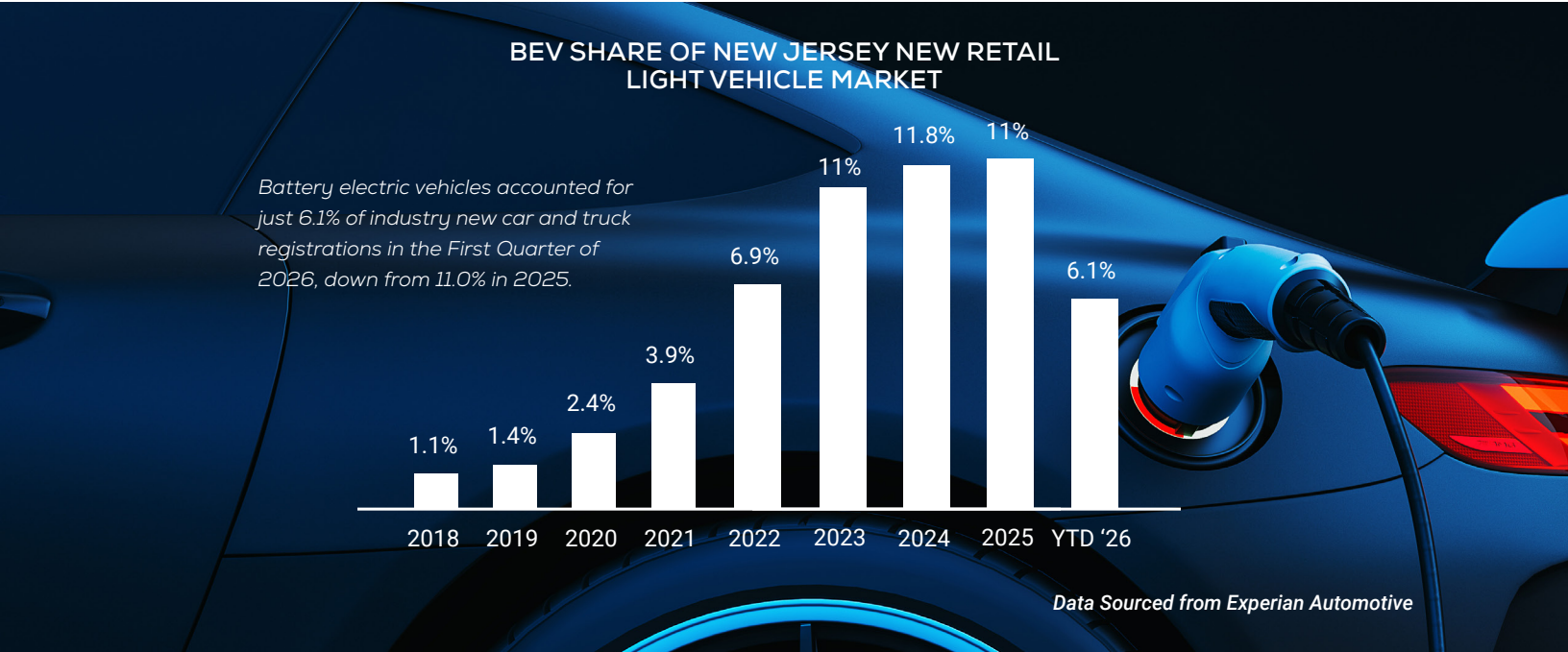


ELECTRIC VEHICLES

New Jersey's Franchised New Car and Truck Dealerships Have Made Significant Investments to Support the Sale and Service of Electric Vehicles

Battery electric vehicle (BEV) market share in New Jersey grew steadily between 2018 and 2024. BEV share declined slightly in 2025 and has dropped sharply in the first quarter of 2026 due largely to the expiration of federal government tax credits.
